#### INTRODUCTION

A **Code Pink** (cardiac arrest/medical emergency – infant/child) is initiated when a suspected cardiac arrest has occurred with a child.

#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL STAFF**

- Upon finding any unresponsive child, notify medical personnel (physician/nurse) immediately.
- Stay with the child until medical personnel arrive and initiate basic life support, if trained.
- Non-medical personnel are to remain away from the Code Pink unless specifically requested to assist.
- Staff who participated in the code are to sign the Emergency Code Staff Participation Record

#### **INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

### **Charge Nurse/Designate**

- Confirm cardiac arrest/medical emergency.
- Notify switchboard to make the announcement.
- Ensure PALS guidelines are followed.
- Maintain order.
- Complete a formal <u>Codes Evaluation Form</u> and forward to the Manager of Support Services (administration).

#### **SWITCHBOARD**

When notified of a **CODE PINK**, announce the following over the PA system:

Attention please, attention please
