Duties Include:

- Performs preventative maintenance tests, audits and activities.
- Maintains building automation systems (BAS), preferably delta, and equipment, including HVAC systems, refrigeration systems, boiler systems, plumbing and sewer systems, food service, laundry, and housekeeping equipment.
- Ability to learn, utilize and remain current with applicable building system technologies
- Identifies and provides required servicing and repairs as required.
- Performs and logs boiler equipment water tests, as well as logs daily systems reports.
- Responds to work orders and requests promptly and efficiently, and tracks time and cost of completing orders.
- Requisitions special supplies and replacement parts as required.
- Works with supervisor to coordinate drills, audits and inspections related to fire safety.
- Applies policies and procedures to ensure consistency of service and standards of performance are attained.
- Maintains working knowledge of building and safety codes.
- In coordination with supervisor, plans and implements activities related to maintenance of the facilities.
- Maintains grounds as required, including snow removal, treatment of ice, etc.
- Removes garbage and/or hazardous material from areas for proper disposal.
- Keeps department and areas clean, tidy and organized and ensures all tools and equipment are labeled, clean and in good working order.
- Maintains all equipment in good working order, reporting deficiencies when required.
