- Collaborates with other members of the interdisciplinary team and community agencies in regards to the planning and coordination of care
- Practising and promoting hospital patient safety initiatives and Joint Health and Safety practices
- Being alert to infection hazards and complies with hospital infection control policies and procedures
- Utilizes emergency care and crisis intervention immediately as required
- Initiates assessment and treatment protocols based on the Canadian Triage and Acuity Scale
